

Ordinance # 283

By Mr. Council.

Granting Murray W. McLeish the right to construct a sewer for ground and surface drainage.

Whereas Murray W. McLeish is building a residence on lot No. 13 in Bryden Park Addition to the village of Bexley and desires to construct a sewer for surface and ground water drainage from the said lot to the storm sewer in Passady Avenue.

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio: to-wit:

Section 1 That Murray W. McLeish be and he is hereby granted the right to construct and keep in repair at his own expense in right and vicinity of the sewer in the first alley north of Bryden Road in said village from lot No. 13 in Bryden Park Addition to the storm water sewer located in Passady Avenue. Provided, that the said McLeish shall not be relieved of any proper assessment for a storm and surface drainage sewer to hereafter be constructed in Bryden Road for the purpose of furnishing storm water drainage for the lots and lands fronting upon said Bryden Road and for surface and storm water drainage for any permanent street improvement that may be hereafter constructed on said Bryden Road.

Section 2 That said sewer shall be constructed in accordance with the flat plan and profile therefor prepared by the engineer of said village and that said McLeish shall save and keep the village harmless from all claims and suits for damages by any person or persons caused by or growing out of the work of constructing said sewer and upon completion thereof shall restore said alley to the former condition and usefulness without unnecessary delay.

Section 3 That an accurate flat and profile of said sewer and a flat showing the lots abutting thereon shall be filed with the Clerk of said village, together with a statement of the cost of constructing said sewer and that no person shall be granted a permit to tap or connect with said sewer unless he or she shall present the Clerk a written receipt from said McLeish his heirs or assigns for a proper proportion of the cost of constructing said sewer provided however that the village may at any time connect with and continue said sewer eastwardly in said alley without paying for said privilege.

Section 4 This ordinance shall not take effect until the said Murray W. McLeish shall have filed with the Clerk of said village his written receipt and of the provisions of this ordinance.

and shall agree that his said property may be assessed for its proper proportion of any storm water drainage that may hereafter be provided and constructed in said Bryden Road for the purposes aforesaid.

Accepted Upon the filing of such written consent and agreement this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
