

Ordinance #289

To accept deed of Beasley Land Co. for highway purposes.

Be it ordered by the Council of the Village of Beasley, State of Ohio.

Section 1. That the deed from the Beasley Land Company executed May 20, 1921, granting to said village a ten foot strip off the south end of lots 55 to 64, including Bullet Park extension for the purpose of widening Fair Avenue and the same thereby is accepted.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
