

## Ordinance # 295-

By Mr. Dunlap -

To amend Section 2 of Ordinance No. 272,  
passed March 15, 1921.Be it ordained by the council of the village of  
Bexley, Ohio;

Sec. 1. That Section 2 of an ordinance No. 272 passed by  
the council of said village on March 15, 1921, be and  
the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. That the assessments levied against  
each lot or parcel of ground as hereinafter set  
forth and directed, shall be payable in twenty  
equal annual installments, with interest at  
the rate of six per cent. <sup>per annum - annually from April 1, 1921</sup> at the  
office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio,  
and the same has been certified to the County  
Auditor for collection in the manner provided by  
law.

Sec. 2 That, as it is necessary for the public welfare  
of the inhabitants of the village that the proceeds  
from the sale of said \$76,000 of bonds be re-  
ceived without delay, this ordinance is here-  
by declared to be an emergency measure, and  
shall be in force from and after its passage.
