

## Ordinance # 298

By Mr. Robt. Wheaton.

To levy special assessments for the improvements of Dawson Ave. from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley Ohio:

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street in said village by grading curbs, paving the roadway with brick or concrete or some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to lay in proper drainage for such improvements and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in Dawson Avenue to the inner line of the curb of said avenue as heretofore levied by an Ordinance No. 274 passed by the Council March 15, 1921 be and the same hereby is adopted and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described and fronting and abutting on said improvements, the several amounts herein set forth, to-wit:

Sections. That the assessments levied against each lot or parcel of ground, as hereinbefore set forth and described shall be payable in ten equal installments with interest on such payments at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum payable semi-annually, from April 1st, 1921, at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified by the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided

by law. If said installments of said assessments are not paid when and as the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon, as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
