

## Ordinance # 301

Determining to proceed with the improvement of Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lane.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley Ohio.

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the improvement of Fair Avenue from Drexel Avenue to Belgard Lane by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with brick asphalt, bituminous, <sup>concrete</sup> or some form of permanent improvement <sup>consistently following ordinance in purpose with drainage for said improvement</sup> constructing a water main and sanitary sewer therein from Cassady Avenue to Belgard Lane and making water and sanitary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue with the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon in accordance with the plans, specifications and profiles of said proposed improvement heretofore approved and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village and in pursuance of the resolution declaring it necessary to improve said avenue adopted by the Council of said Village on the 2 day of June 1921.

Section 2. That all claims for damages resulting from such improvement shall be judiciously inquired into after the completion thereof and the village solicitor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to institute proceedings in a court of common jurisdiction to inquire into such complaints.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth ( $\frac{1}{50}$ ) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed by the foot frontage upon the following described lots and lands to-wit:

All lots and lands fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement and in an amount equal to that portion of the cost to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the sum of \$\_\_\_\_\_ be and hereby is appropriated from the street improvement and

intersection fund to pay the remainder of the cost of said improvement.

Section 5. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten equal annual installments with interest on the deferred payments at a rate not to exceed six per cent (6%) per annum.

Section 6. That bonds of said village shall be issued in the anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installment, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 7. That the clerk of said village be and he is hereby authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
