

## Ordinance # 302

Declaring it necessary to construct and determining to proceed with the construction of a sanitary relief sewer between lots one and fifty-eight Stanbery Place.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, state of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is deemed necessary to construct and it hereby is determined to proceed to construct a ten inch sanitary relief sewer along or upon a right of way granted by the Forresh Realty Company, for that purpose, said right of way being a strip of ground eight feet in width, and being approximately four feet in width on each side of the line between lot number one (1) and fifty-eight (58) of Stanbery Place addition to said village, and said sewer to commence at a point in said right of way one hundred and thirty (130) feet west of the west line of Cassady Avenue at the eastern terminus of a sewer constructed by the Forresh Realty Company and to extend eastwardly from said point to the first man hole north of Broad Street, over the sanitary sewer in Cassady Avenue.

Section 2. That said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe, ten inches in diameter and in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk of said village.

Section 3. That the whole cost of constructing said sewer shall be paid by said village from its sewer fund, the proceeds of the sale of bonds heretofore authorized for sewer purposes; and the sum of \$ 495<sup>00</sup> is hereby appropriated from said fund to pay such cost.

Section 4. That the Mayor and Clerk be and hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said work according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
