

Ordinance # 304

To narrow Bexley Drive to the width of fifty feet from Livingston Avenue to the north line of Bexley drive subdivision No. 2.

Whereas, in the opinion of the council of the Village of Bexley, there is good cause for narrowing Bexley drive in said village to a width of fifty (50) feet from Livingston Avenue to the north line of Bexley drive subdivision No. 2; and that it will not be detrimental to the general interest to vacate a strip five in width off of each side of drive for the purpose of narrowing the same as aforesaid,

Now Therefore, be it ordained by the Council of the village of Bexley, state of Ohio:

Sec. 1. That a strip of ground five feet in width off of each side of Bexley drive from Livingston Avenue to the north line of Bexley drive subdivision No. 2 be and the same hereby is vacated, and that said drive be and the same hereby is narrowed from sixty to fifty feet in width between the points aforesaid.

Sec. 2. That this ordinance be and remain in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
