

Ordinance 305

Determining to proceed with the construction of part of the sewer shown in the plan of sewer district no. 2

By ordinance of the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio.

Section 1

That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of that part of the sewer in sewer district no. 2 of said village as follows, to-wit: an eight inch sanitary sewer in the first alley east of Parkview Avenue and in the first alley east of Parkview Avenue in Bexley Heights Addition of said village from the main sanitary sewer in Parkview Avenue to the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company, pursuant to a resolution adopted on the 11th day of October, 1921, and in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore prepared by the said village for a system of sewerage in said district, adopted by the council on the 11th day of June 1918, and now on file in the office of the clerk of said village.

Said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe in accordance with said plans and specifications.

Section 2

That the entire cost of said improvements shall be assessed by the lot front upon the following lots and lands to-wit:

The cost of constructing the sewer in the first alley east of Parkview Avenue between Parkview Avenue and the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company, upon all the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, and the cost of constructing the sewer in the first alley east of Parkview Avenue between Parkview Avenue and the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company upon all the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvements and in an amount equal to the cost thereof per front foot.

Section 3

That assessments so to be levied shall be paid in two equal semi-annual installments with interest on deferred payments at six per cent (6%) per annum, and in default of such payment the same shall be certified to the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes with penalties as provided by law, provided that the owner of any property may, at his option, pay such assessment in cash within thirty (30) days after the passing of the assessing ordinance upon due notice being given.

Section 4

That the clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Article 5 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the first period allowed by law.
