

Ordinance ²³⁰⁸

To accept deed of Charles F. Wansberg and wife conveying land for street purposes.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Dupuy, State of Ohio.

Section 1 That the deed of Chas. F. Wansberg and wife executed November 16 1921 conveying four certain parcels of ground here-in described to said village for the use of the public for street purposes forever the first tract to widen Dawson Avenue, the second tract to widen Cassady Avenue, the fourth tract to widen Elm Avenue and the third tract to be known as Seneca Avenue, be and the same hereby is accepted, and said tracts are dedicated to highway purposes forever.

Section 2 That the said public body is directed to cause said deed to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3 This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
