

Resolution No. 263. ✓

Appointing a board to report an estimated assessment of the cost of constructing a sanitary sewer pursuant to Ordinance No. 282, passed April 26, 1921 and repealing Resolution No. 259, adopted December 13, 1921.

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that E. E. Legg, E. D. Barnett and D. P. Cooke, three disinterested freeholders of the village be and they are hereby appointed a board to estimate an assessment of the cost, less one-fiftieth thereof, of constructing a sanitary sewer in sewer district No. 4 commencing at the main sewer in said district thence in the first alley south of Astor Avenue to the alley between Euclaire Avenue and Bexley Plaza; thence in the alley between Euclaire Avenue and Bexley Plaza to the first alley south of Main Street; thence in the first alley south of Main Street to the east curb line of Center Avenue, upon all of the lots and lands fronting or abutting upon said improvement, in proportion, as nearly as may be, to the benefits which may result from said sewer to the lots and lands so assessed, and report said estimated assessment to this council.

Resolved further that Resolution No. 259, adopted December 13, 1921, be and the same hereby is repealed.

NOTICE OF ASSESSMENT.

Notice is hereby given that the estimated assessment of the cost of constructing sanitary sewers in sewer district No. 4, in the village of Bexley, Ohio, commencing at the main sewer in said district; thence in the first alley south of Astor Ave.; thence easterly in said alley to the alley between Euclaire Ave. and Bexley Plaza; thence in said last named alley to the first alley south of Main St.; thence east in the first alley south of Main St. to the east curb line of Center Ave. upon the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in a resolution No. 226, to construct said sewers, adopted March 15, 1921, has been made and reported to council.

Also that the estimated assessment of the cost of constructing sanitary sewers in sewer district No. 4 in said village commencing in Euclaire Ave. twenty (20) feet south of Charles St.; thence south in Euclaire Ave. to Livingston Ave.; thence along the north line of Livingston Ave. to a point where said sewer connects with the main trunk sewer in Livingston Ave. upon the lots and lands benefited and to be charged therewith as set forth in a resolution No. 228, to construct said sewers, adopted March 22, 1921, has been made and reported to council.

Said estimated assessments are now on file in the office of the clerk of the council of said village for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein.
