Declaring it necessary to improve Connecticat Avenue from Dawsen Avenue to Cassady Avenue.

Phereas, the owners of three-fourths, or more, in interest of the preperty fronting and abutting upon Connecticut Avenue between Dewson Avenue and Cassady
Avenue, in the Village of Berley, Offic, have filed their written petition with the
council of said village, praying such council to pass the necessary legislation
therefor, and to improve said Connecticut Avenue by grading, carbing and paving the
readway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, consrete or some other form of
permanent improvement, constructing sowers necessary to furnish proper drainage
for such improvement, and making water and samitary sower connections to the lets
and lands fronting and abutting thereon, and consenting that the entire cost of said
improvement, except such portion as is by law chargeable against said village, may be
assessed and collected in equal annual installments in proportion to the whole assessment in such manner as may be fixed by the council, and,

Whereas, said petitioners and each of them also consent and request that said assessments be levied and collected without reference to the value of the property of the subscribers and waive all benefits of the provisions of Section 5619 of the General Code limiting assessments to thirty-three and one-third per cent.

(55 1/36) of the value of the property assessed for any and all purposes within the period of five years; and also waive the benefits of the provisions of Section 5814, 5918 and 5895 of the General Code providing for the service and publication of notice of the proceedings for the construction of said imprevenent, and the making and levying of the assessments therefor,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Chie:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve said Connecticut Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue, by grading, curbing, and paving the roadway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement; constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, and making water and samitary sewer connections from the water main and samitary sewer in said avenue to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereom, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of said proposed improvement prepared by the engineers of said village, which plans, specifications, estimates and profile with the clock of said village.

gestion 2. That the grade of said avenue as improved, shall be as shown on the plane and profile aforesaid and the grade of the earlie shall be as follows, to-wit:

Borth Curbe

Commencing at the east property line of Dawson Avenue at sta. 0 plus 00 and at an elevation of 109-13; themee east with a 5/10 ascending grade to Sta. 5 plus 52 west property line of Cassady Avenue and elevation 110,86.

south ourb:

Some elevation as north ourb.

All above elevations are referred to Village Datum.

Section 5. That the whole cost of said improvement, loss machiftieth (1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections shall be assessed by the foot front upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said proposed imprevement, which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be especially benefited by said improvement, and in sm amount equal to the cost thereof. not less than sind or more than

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in ten equal summal installments with interest on deferred payments, at a rate not excooding six per cent. (6%) per amoum.

Section 5. That bends of said villages shall be isgued in anticipation of the collection of the assessments by installments, and in amount equal thereto.

Section 6. That the remainder of the entire cost of said improvement shall be paid by the issue of bonds of said village in the manner previded by laws

Section 7. This Resolution to take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
