

RESOLUTION NO. 276. ✓

To cancel and not issue certain of a series of bonds authorized to be issued in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the improvement of Cassady Avenue.

Whereas, said council on the 14th day of February, 1922, passed an ordinance authorizing the issue of bonds of the village of Bexley in the aggregate amount of \$60,000.00 in anticipation of the levy of special assessments for the improvement of Cassady Avenue from Broad Street to Brentwood Road.

Whereas, bids have been received and a contract awarded for said improvement which rendered it unnecessary to issue bonds in excess of \$48,000.00 in anticipation of the levy of assessments for said improvement, now therefore

Be It Resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley,

State of Ohio:

Section 1. That bonds numbers one to six both inclusive, and bonds numbers fifty-five to sixty both inclusive of said authorized issue be cancelled and not issued, and that bonds numbers seven to fifty-four both inclusive be issued.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
