

RESOLUTION NO. 279.

Declaring it necessary to improve Main Street from Roche Avenue to Peck Avenue on the south side of Main Street by the construction of a water line therein.

Whereas, the owners of three-fourths or more in interest of the property fronting and abutting on the south side of Main Street between Roche Avenue and Peck Avenue in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, have filed their written petition with the council of said village, praying said council to pass the necessary legislation therefor and to improve said Main Street between said points by constructing therein an eight inch water main with necessary fire hydrants, and consenting that the entire cost thereof shall be assessed by the foot frontage upon the lots and lands fronting and abutting upon said Main Street between the points aforesaid and collected in equal annual installments in such manner and within such period as may be fixed by said council, and

Whereas, said petitioners in said petition did expressly waive all benefits of the privileges of Section 3619 of the General Code, limiting the aggregate amount of all assessments that may be levied upon their property within five years, and also did expressly waive the benefits of the provisions of Section 3614, 3616 and 3695, providing for the service and publication of notice of the proceedings for the construction of said water line, and the making and levying of the assessments therefor, and

Whereas, said petitioners also in their petition consented and agreed that the cost of constructing said water line, to be assessed as aforesaid, shall include the cost of constructing an eight inch (8") water line in Main Street from Roche Avenue to Peck Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve said Main Street from Roche Avenue to Peck Avenue by constructing therein an eight inch (8") water line with necessary valves and hydrants.

Section 2. That the grade of said avenue as improved in accordance with this resolution shall be the existing grade.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be assessed by the foot frontage upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands ^{on the south side of main street} fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said

lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefitted by said improvement in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at a rate not exceeding six per centum (6%) per annum.

Section 5. That bonds of said village shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and the collection of assessments by installments, and in an amount equal thereto.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
