RESOLUTION NO. 280.

To approve the amended plans of the sewer districts of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, heretofore established creating and establishing an additional district designated and numbered No. 5.

WHEREAS, the Council of said village, on the 25th day of April, 1922, did by resolution direct the engineers of said village to prepare and forthwith submit an amendment to the sewer district plans of said village numbered one, two, three and four, which amended plans should constitute an additional sewer district to be designated No. 5, and,

WHEREAS, said engineers upon the adoption of said resolution, did forthwith present to the council and file with the clerk an amendment to the sewer district plans theretofore adopted showing a new and additional sewer district numbered Sanitary Sewer District No. 5, and,

WHEREAS, notice of the preparation and filing of said plan of sewer district No. 5 was published for more than ten days, prior to the 23rd of May, as required by law, and,

WHEREAS, no objections have been filed with the Council to such plan.

NOW THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that said plans for sewer district No. 5, be and the same hereby are approved, adopted and confirmed.

Be it further resolved, that the part of the sewers in said district No. 5 hereby designated for immediate construction is as follows:

An eight (8) inch sanitary sewer in the first alley East of Peck Avenue from the first alley south of Main Street to the center of Astor Avenue; and also an eight (8) inch sanitary sewer in the first alley West of Peck Avenue from the first alley south of Main Street to the center of Astor Avenue, together with an eight (8) inch sewer in Astor Avenue from the first alley east of Peck Avenue to Roche Avenue.
