RESOLUTION NO. 295.

Declaring it necessary to issue bonds for the purpose of paying the cost of erecting and installing poles, wires, conduits, lamps and other necessary fixtures for supplying electricity in the corporation of the village of Bexley and to the inhabitants thereof.

Be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of Berley. State of thie, two thirds of all its members elected thereto concurring, that it is necessary to issue and sell bonds of said village in the sum of

Dollars (\$\frac{1}{2}\$), for the purpose of paying the cost and expense of erecting and installing poles, wires, conduits, lamps and other necessary fixtures for supplying electricity in the corporation of the Village of Bexley and to the inhabitants thereof, and that the question of issuing and selling said bonds for said purpose in the sum aforesaid be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of said village at the general election to be held in said village at the regular voting places, on the 7th day of November, 1922; and said election shall be conducted, canvassed and certified in the same manner as other general municipal elections.

That the mayor be, and he hereby is, directed to give proper notice of the time and place of holding said election in the mar or provided by law.

That the clerk be and he hereby is directed to certify a copy of this resolution to the Deputy State Supervisors of Elections of Frankline County, Chio
