

RESOLUTION NO. 296.

By Mr. Manly.

To appoint a board to report an estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of improving Cassady Avenue.

Whereas it had been determined by the council to assess the whole cost less one-fiftieth and the cost of intersections of the improvement of Cassady Avenue in proportion to the benefits that may result from said improvement, now therefor:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Bexley, Ohio, that A. W. Zimmer, J. T. Elder and C. E. Underwood, three disinterested free holders of the village be and they hereby are appointed a board to estimate the assessment of such cost on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in an ordinance No. 290 to improve said Avenue, passed June 2, 1921, in proportion to, as nearly as may be, to the benefits which may result from the improvement to the several lots and parcels of land so assessed and to report to this council said estimated assessment.
