

RESOLUTION NO. 300.

To amend Section "d" of Resolution No. 163, adopted July 24, 1917, entitled "Resolution No. 163 declaring it necessary to improve Ashbourne Place."

Be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Ohio:-

Section 1. That Section "d" of Resolution No. 163 adopted July 24, 1917, entitled "Resolution No. 163 declaring it necessary to improve Ashbourne Place in said village, by grading, curbing and improving, etc., being amended to read as follows,

Section "d". That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine (9) equal annual installments, with interest on deferred payments at the rate of five and one-half (5½%) per cent per annum payable semi-annually.

Section 2. That original Section "d" of said Resolution No. 163 be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
