To amend Section "d" of Resolution No. 164 adopted July 24, 1917, entitled "Resolution No. 164 declaring it necessary to improve Ashbourne Road, ~~in said village by curbing, grading and paving etc.~~

Be it Resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley,

State of Ohio,

Section 1. That Section "d" of Resolution No. 164 adopted July 24, 1917, declaring it necessary to improve Ashbourne Road in said village, by curbing, grading and paving etc., be amended to read as follows:

Section "d". That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine (9) equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred payments at the rate of 5½% per annum payable semi-annually.

Section 2. That original Section "d" of said Resolution No. 164 be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
