By Mr. Menly.

Declaring it necessary to improve Bexley Plaza from Charles Street to the first alley south of Main Street, by constructing a six inch water line therein.

Whereas the owners of more than three fourths in interest of the property fronting and abutting on Bexley Plaza from Charles Street to the first alley outh of Main Street in the Village of Bexley, Chio, have filed their written petition with the council of said village praying said council to pass the necessary legislation therefor and to improve said Bexley Plaza between the points aforesaid by constructing therein a six (6) inch water line with necessary fire hydrants and to assess the entire cost of said improvement, except only such portion as is chargeable by law against the village, by the foot front upon the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon and collects the same in equal annual installments in such manner as may be fixed by the Council, etc.

NOW THEREFORE? be it resolved by the council of the Village of Bexley. State of Chio:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Bexley Plaza from Charles Street to the first alley south of Main Street by constructing therein a six (6) inch water line, with necessary fire hydrants, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles for the proposed improvement on file in the office of the Village Clerk, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles hereby are approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said Bexley Plaza, as improved, shall be the existing grade as shown upon the plans and profiles aforesaid.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth thereof shall be assessed by the front foot upon the following described lets and lands, towit: All the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially be affiled by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the case leaveby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bends to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection thereof.

Section 5. That bonds of said village shall be issued in antici-

pation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, and in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which the assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds to be issued by said village in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law. Adopted Octobere 101 1922.
