

An ordinance No. 310.

Declaring it necessary to construct and determining to proceed with the construction of a sanitary sewer along and upon the right of way of The I. C. & E. Traction Company.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is deemed necessary to construct and it hereby is determined to proceed with the construction of an eight inch sanitary sewer along and upon the right of way of The I. C. & E. Traction Company and north of the tracks of said company from the sewer to be constructed in Bexley Drive, westward to the main sewer, a distance of approximately Two Hundred Sixty (260) feet.

Section 2. That said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe, eight inches in diameter, and in accordance with the plans and specifications on file in the office of the Clerk of said village.

Section 3. That one half of the cost of construction of said sewer shall be paid by said village from its sewer fund, the proceeds of the sale of bonds heretofore authorized for sewer purposes; and the sum of \$225 is hereby appropriated from said fund to pay such cost.

Section 4. That the mayor and Clerk be and hereby are authorized and directed to enter into a contract for said work according to law.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
