An Ordinance No. 311.

To levy special assessments for the construction of sidewalks on College Avenue, between Livingston Avenue and Main St.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That to pay the cost and expense of constructing cartain sidewalks in front of lots hereinafter described, situated on College Avenue in said village between Livingston Avenue and Main Street, in accordance with a resolution of Council heretoforeadopted, there be levied and assessed upon the following described lots the several amounts hereinafter set forth, viz:

Section 2. That the owners of the several lots assessed aforesaid, shall pay the amounts of money from them severally due in that behalf to the Village Treasurer within thirty days after the dateof the final passage of this ordinance, and if not so paid the assessments shall be certified to the county auditor, to be placed upon the tax duplicate and collected with a penalty of five per cent. (5%) as provided by law.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
