> All lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the preposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be sp specially benefited by said improvement in the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon.

Section 2. That section 3 of said resolution declaring it necessary to impreve said ardmore Read as aforesaid be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
