

RESOLUTION NO. 314. ✓

To amend Section three (3) of a resolution adopted October 19, 1922, entitled "Resolution No. 309 declaring it necessary to improve Ardmore Road from Broad Street north to the north line of lots 705 and 782 of Ardmore Addition No. 2 by paving".

Be it resolved by Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Section 3 of a resolution adopted October 19, 1922, entitled, "Resolution No. 309 declaring it necessary to improve Ardmore Road from Broad Street north to the north line of lots 705 and 782 of Ardmore Addition No. 2, by paving" be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

All lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement in the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon.

Section 2. That section 3 of said resolution declaring it necessary to improve said Ardmore Road as aforesaid be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
