

## RESOLUTION NO. 315 ✓

To amend Section three (3) of a resolution adopted April 26, 1922, entitled "Resolution No. 272 declaring it necessary to improve Cassingham Road from Broad Street north to the north line of lots 627 and 704 of Ardmore Addition by paving."

Be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Section three (3) of a resolution adopted April 20, 1922, entitled "Resolution No. 272 declaring it necessary to improve Cassingham Road from Broad Street north to the north line of lots 672 and 704 of Ardmore Addition No. 2 by paving", be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following lots and lands, to-wit: All of the lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement between the points aforesaid, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement in the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon".

Section 2. That Section three (3) of said original resolution declaring it necessary to improve said Ardmore Road as aforesaid be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
