

RESOLUTION NO. 316 ✓

Declaring it necessary to improve Remington Road from Broad Street north to the north line of lots 532 and 626 of Ardmore Addition No. 2 by paving.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Remington Road from Broad Street to the north of lots 532 and 626 of Ardmore Addition No. 2, in said village, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form of permanent improvement, constructing the necessary storm sewers to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line in said road between the points aforesaid, with necessary fire hydrants and making water connections therefrom to the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvement prepared by the engineers of said village and now on file in the office of the village clerk, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles hereby are approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said road as improved shall be, the grade shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid, and the grade of the curbs shall be as follows, to-wit:

EAST and WEST CURBS- Beginning at the north curb line of Broad Street Station 0 - 35 and elevation 119.10; thence northerly with a 0.20% descending grade to Station 5 + 00, elevation 118.10; thence northerly with a 0.20% ascending grade to the south property line of Maryland Avenue, Station 21 + 29, elevation 121.36

Above elevations refer to Village Datum.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less-one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof, and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount equal to that part of the cost thereof hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine (9) or more than ten (10) equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection thereof.

Section 5. That bonds of said village of Bexley shall be issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of assessments by installments,

and in an amount sufficient to pay that portion of the estimated cost of the improvement for which the assessments are to be levied.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvement shall be paid from the proceeds of bonds of said village, to be issued in the manner provided by law.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
