Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement, less one-fiftieth (1/50) thereof and the cost of intersections shall be assessed in propertion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following described lets and lands, to-wit:

All lets and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which said lets and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement in the amount hereby determined to be specially assessed thereon.

Section 2. That Section 3.of said resolution declaring it nonessary to improve Bexley Plaza as aforesaid be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect and be in force

from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
