

An Ordinance No. 318.

To levy special assessments for the construction of a part of the sewers in sanitary sewer district No. 2.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That to pay the portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the construction of that part of the sewers shown upon the plan of sewer district No. 2, to-wit: An eight inch sanitary sewer in the first alley east of Parkview Avenue and in the first alley east of Columbus Avenue in Bexley Heights Addition to said village from the main sanitary sewer in Caroline Avenue to the right of way of the B. & O. Railroad Company, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described, the several amounts herein set forth to-wit:

Which said assessments are \$_____ and _____ cents per front foot of the property assessed, and it is hereby determined and declared that each of said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment thereon levied.

Section 2. That the total assessment hereby levied shall be

payable in cash within thirty days after the passage of this ordinance, or in two equal semi-annual installments with interest at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, upon deferred payments, at the option of the owner. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of the village. If said assessments are not paid in cash as herein provided, all installments of assessments shall be certified by the clerk of the village to the county auditor, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
