

## RESOLUTION NO. 318. ✓

By Mr. O. P. Dunlop.

To appoint a Board to report an estimated assessment to pay the cost and expense of constructing that part of the sanitary sewer district No. 5 described in Resolution No. 282, adopted May 23, 1922.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio, that J. T. Elder, G. R. Wannemacher and C. E. Underwood, three disinterested freeholders of said Village be and they hereby are appointed a board to estimate the assessment of the cost of constructing the sewers described in said resolution adopted May 23, 1922, on the lots and lands to be charged therewith as set forth in ordinance No. 350 determining to proceed with the construction of said sewers, passed June 27, 1922, in proportion as nearly as may be to the benefits which may result from said improvement to the several lots or parcels of land so assessed and report to this Council said estimated assessment.
