

AN ORDINANCE NO.320.

To fix the location and width and to establish the grade of sidewalks on Dawson Avenue between Fair Avenue and Broad Street.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio;

SECTION 1. That the sidewalks, where constructed, on Dawson Avenue between Fair Avenue and Broad Street shall be not less than five (5) feet in width, with the inner edge thereof four (4) feet from the property line. The foot of the terrace slope shall be not less than one (1) foot from the inner edge of said walks.

SECTION 2. That the grade of the back or inner edge of the walks located as aforesaid shall be as follows: The inner edge of said sidewalk on both east and west sides of said avenue shall be sixteen (16) inches above the top of the curb and shall run parallel therewith. Such walks shall have a cross slope of three-eighths ($3/8$) of an inch per foot.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
