

AN ORDINANCE NO. 32

By Mr. R. J. Wheaton.

To fix the location and width and to establish the grade of sidewalks on Euclaire Avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. That the sidewalks, when constructed, on Euclaire Avenue between Main Street and Livingston Avenue shall be not less than five (5) feet in width, with the inner edge thereof one (1) foot from the property line. The foot of the terrace slope shall be not less than one (1) foot from the inner edge of said walk.

SECTION 2. The grade of the back or inner edge of the walks so located on both the east and west sides of said avenue shall be five and one-eighths ($5 \frac{1}{8}$) inches above the top of the curb, and shall run parallel therewith. Such sidewalks shall have a cross slope of three-eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$) of an inch per foot.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
