RESOLUTION NO. 321. ✓

Declaring it necessary to impreve Reche Avenue between Main Street and Mound Street.

Be it reselved by the council of the Village of Berley, State of

Onio:

Section 1. That it is necessary to improve Reche Avenue between main Street and Meund Street in said village, by grading, curbing and improving the readway with brick, asphalt, bitulithic, tarvia, concrete or some other form permanent improvement, constructing the necessary sterm sewers to furnish proper drainage for such improvement, constructing a six inch water line with necessary fire hydrants in said avenue between the points aforesaid, and making water commections therefrom to the lets and lands fronting and abutting thereon, in accordance with the plans, specifications, estimates and profiles of the proposed improvements propared by the engineers of said village and new on file in the effice of the village clork, which plans, specifications, estimates and profiles hereby are approved.

Section 2. That the grade of said avenue as improved shall be the grade shown by and upon the plans and profiles aforesaid, and the grade of the curbs shall be as follows. to-wit:

East and West Curb.

Beginning at the seuth preperty line of Meund Street, Station 17 ± 70, and elevation 107.10; thence northerly with a 0.36% ascending grade to the south property line of Main Street. Station 25 ± 02, and elevation 109.75.

Abeve elevations refer to Village Datum.

Section 5. That one -half the cost of said improvement, and the cost of intersections, shall be paid by said village and the remaining one-half shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits which may result from said improvement, upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon the east side of said proposed improvement, which said lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in thereof an amount equal to that part of the estimated cost marriary determined to be assessed thereon.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in not less than nine or more than ten equal annual installments, with interest on the deferred payments at the same rate as shall be berne by the bends to be nereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of such assessments.

Section 5. That pends of said village shall be is med in

anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessments, in an amount sufficient to pay that perties of the estimated cost of said improvement hereinbefore determined to be assessed upon the preperty fronting and moutting thereon.

Section 6. That the remainder of the cost of said improvements shall be paid either from the preceeds of bends of said village issued in the manner provided by law, or from the street improvement funds of said village.

Section 7. This resolution shall take effect and be in ferce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
