

An Ordinance No. 323.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street, and to repeal ordinance No. 274, passed March 15, 1921.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That to pay the portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Dawson Avenue from Fair Avenue to the improved roadway of Broad Street in said village by grading, curbing, paving the roadway with brick, concrete, or some form of asphalt or some form of treated macadam, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and constructing water and sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said Dawson Avenue to the inner line of the curbs on said avenue, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described and fronting and abutting upon said improvements, the several amounts hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

Section 2. That the assessments levied against each lot or parcel of ground, as hereinbefore set forth and described, shall be payable in ten equal annual installments with interest on such payments at the rate of six per cent. (6%) per annum payable semi-annually, from October 1st., 1921, at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, after the same has been certified by the County Auditor for collection in the manner provided by law. If said installments of said assessments are not paid when and as the same become due, a penalty will be imposed and collected as provided by law.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be paid into the sinking fund and shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the collection of assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon, as the same shall become due and to no other purpose whatsoever.

Section 4. That ordinance No. 274, passed March 15, 1921, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
