Be it ordained by the council of the village of Bemley, State of Chie: Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of constructing a part of the sauitary sewers in sewer district No. 4 of said village commencing at . the main sewer in said district where it intersects the first alley south of Astor Avenue; themse east in said alley to the alley between Enclaire Avenue and Bexley Plaza; thence neith in said last named alley to the first alley south of Main Street; themse easterly in the alley south of Main Street to the east ourb of Center Avenue, amounting in the aggregate te . . . , as reported to this council February 14th, 1922, by the board heretofers sypointed to estimate said assessment, notice of the filing of which assessment has been published as required by law, be and the same hereby is adopted and confirmed, and that there be and hereby is levied upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said sewer improvement the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments, together with the description of said lots and lands, are now on file in the office of the clerk of this council. Said assessments are in properties to and not in excess of the special bemefits to said property, and are as fellows to-wit:

(6%) per annum, payable semi-enumally.
