

**Ordinance No. 327.**

**By Mr. Frye.**

Determining to proceed with the construction of a part of the sewers in sanitary sewer district No. 4 as established March 15, 1921.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Oakley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That it is hereby determined to proceed with the construction of a part of the sewers provided for upon amended plan for a system of sanitary sewers for said village and designated as sanitary sewer district No. 4, which amended plan was adopted by the Council on the 15th day of March, 1921, and is now on file in the office of the clerk of said village; and that the part or portion of the work provided for in said amended plan, which it is hereby determined to construct is as follows:

An eight inch sewer in the alley between Cassady Avenue and Ardmore Road commencing at a man-hole in the center of Powell Avenue, six feet west of the center line of said alley; thence extending north in said alley and six feet west of the center line thereof to a manhole six feet south of the center line of the first alley south of Broad Street.

Section 2. That said sewer shall be constructed of vitrified sewer pipe and brick man-holes with iron covers, in accordance with plans and specifications heretofore prepared by the Engineers of said village for a system of sanitary sewers for said district, adopted by the Council March 15, 1921, and now on file in the office of the Village Clerk.

Section 3. That the cost of constructing said sewer shall be assessed by the front feet upon the following described lots and lands in said district No. 4, to-wit: All of the lots and lands fronting, bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement, which lots and lands hereby are determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in five equal annual installments, with interest at six per cent (6%) per annum payable semi-annually; provided, however, if bonds or notes of said village are issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of said assessment, and such bonds or notes bear a rate of interest less than six per cent (6%) per annum then such deferred payments shall bear the same rate of interest as is borne by such bonds or notes.

Section 5. That the clerk be and hereby is authorized and directed to advertise for bids for the construction of said improvement according to law.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and

after the earliest period allowed by law.
