

## AN ORDINANCE NO. 338.

To create and appoint a planning commission.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That there shall be and hereby is created a planning Commission for the Village of Bexley, Ohio; and that said Commission shall have all the power set forth in the act of the general assembly of the State of Ohio passed February 4th, 1920, 108 Ohio laws 1175.

Section 2. That the persons whose names are hereinafter set forth, to-wit: Mr. H. B. Coleman, Mr. J. Edward Zangmaster, Mr. Orlando C. Miller, Dr. Charles H. Wells, Mr. J. P. Elder, Mrs. Wm. Fell Brown, and Mrs. Wm. P. Tracy, be and the same hereby are appointed to be a Planning Commission for said village.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
