

AN ORDINANCE NO. 339.

By Mr. O. C. Manly.

To provide for the appointment of a Deputy Marshall for the Village of Bexley.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the office of Deputy Marshall of said village be and hereby is created and established; and that the mayor, subject to confirmation by council, be and hereby is empowered to appoint a suitable person as Deputy Marshal of said village, either with or without pay.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
