

AN ORDINANCE NO. 351.

To accept deed of John W. Connell and wife conveying land for highway purposes.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the deed of John. W. Connell and wife executed June 5th, 1922, conveying a certain parcel of ground here-in described to said village for the use of the public for highway purposes, as follows:

A strip of ground fifteen (15) feet in width extending from the west line of said two (2) acre tract to the west line of Belgard Lane, the south line of said fifteen (15) foot strip to be parallel to and one hundred and sixty-one and nine hundredths (161.09) feet north of the north line of Main Street.

be and the same hereby is accepted, and said tract is dedicated to highway purposes forever.

Section 2. That the Clerk hereby is directed to cause said deed to be recorded in the office of the Recorder of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
