## AN ORDINANCE NO. 353.

Section 1. Section 2. That all claims for damages for making said improvement shall be judicially inquired into after the completion thereof, and the solicitor be smile hereby is anthorized and discreted to institute proceedings in a court of competent jurisdiction to impuire into such claims.

Section 3. That the whole cost of said improvement shall be assessed in prepartion to the benefits which may result from said improvement upon the following lots and lands, to-wit: Lot numbers fourteen (14), fifteen (15), sixteen (16), seventeen (17), thirty-four (34), thirty-five (35), thirty-six (36)Q thirty-seven (37), and thirty-eight (36), of Bexley Heights addition to said village, which lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement and in an amount hereby determined to be assessed thereon.

Section That the whole assessment so to be levied shall be paid in cash to the village of where within ten days after notice of the passage of the ordinance level where wents, and in default of such payment the assessments shall be forthwise the tax deplicate and collected as other taxes with interest at six per contents as a provided by law.
