

AN ORDINANCE NO. 356.

By Mr. Dunlop.

To authorize the Trustees of Public Affairs to expend an additional sum of \$200.00 for the construction of a water line in Center Avenue from first alley south of Main Street to Main Street and in Main Street from Center Avenue to Roche Avenue.

Whereas, on April 26, 1922, the council authorized said board to expend the sum of \$1300.00 in the construction of said water line, and

Whereas, engineering, advertising and other incidental expenses resulting from the construction of said line will cause an additional expense of \$200.00, NOW, THEREFORE,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the trustees of Public Affairs of said village be and hereby are authorized to spend an additional sum of \$200.00 to pay the costs incident to the construction of said water line which sum is hereby appropriated from the proceeds of the bonds heretofore issued for water works purposes.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
