

AN ORDINANCE NO. 360.

By Mr. O. C. Manly.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Main Street from Roche Avenue to Peck Avenue by constructing a water line.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That, to pay the cost and expense of improving Main Street from Roche Avenue to Peck Avenue in said village by constructing therein an eight (8) inch water line with necessary valves and hydrants, amounting in aggregate to \$929.87 as reported to the council by the village engineers, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and ~~land~~ hereinafter described, and bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts set forth, to-wit:

And it hereby is determined and declared by this council that each of said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected; and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in five equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of five and one-half per cent. (5½%) per annum payable semi-annually, from the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof shall be applied to reimburse the village for money expended from the water fund in paying the cost of said improvement.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
