

AN ORDINANCE NO. 361.

By Mr. O. P. Dunlop.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Dale Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That, to pay that portion of the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Dale Avenue from Dawson Avenue to Cassady Avenue, in said village, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with asphalt, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for such improvement and making water and sanitary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewer in said avenue with the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, amounting in the aggregate to \$5416.61 as reported to this council by the engineers of said village, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereafter described, and bounding and abutting upon said improvement the several amounts herein set forth, to-wit:

And it hereby is determined and declared by this council that each of said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor as provided by law, to be by him placed on the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected, and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the County Treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in ten equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of five and one-half per cent. (5½%) per annum payable semi-annually from

the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and collection of special assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same becomes due and to no other purpose.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
