To levy special assessments for the improvement of Cassady Avenue from Broad Street to Brentwood Road.

Be it Ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Section 1. That the assessment of the cost and expense of improving Cassady Avenue from Broad Street to Brentwood Road, in said village, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with asphalt, constructing sewers necessary to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, and making water and sanitary sewer connections from the water main and sanitary sewers in said avenue with the lots and lands fronting and abutting thereon, amounting in the aggregate to \$ as reported to this council on the 12th day of August, 1922, by a board heretofore appointed to estimate said assessment, notice of the filling of which has been given as required by law, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed, and that there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement as hereafter set forth, the several amounts hereinafter set forth, to-wit:

It hereby is determined and declared that each of said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment thereen.

Section 2. That the assessments aforesaid, against each lot er parcel of land shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the county auditor and be collected by him as required by law and shall be payable in ten equal annual installments at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, with interest en deferred payments at the rate of five and one-half (51%) per cent per annum payable semi-annually, from and after the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in ferce from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
