

An Ordinance No. 766.

To levy special assessments for the improvement of Ardmore Road from Elm Avenue to the first alley south of Broad Street by constructing a water line therein.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That, to pay the cost and expense heretofore determined to be specially assessed for the improvement of Ardmore Road in said village, from Elm Avenue to the first alley south of Broad Street, by constructing therein a six inch (6") water line with necessary fire hydrants, together with an eight (8) inch water line in Powell Avenue from Cassady Avenue to Ardmore Road, to tie in the line constructed in Ardmore Road with a line heretofore constructed in Cassady Avenue, amounting in the aggregate to \$3351.47 as reported to this council by the engineers of said village, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands herein-after described, and bounding and abutting upon said "Road" the several amounts as follows, to-wit:

and it is hereby determined and declared by this council that each of said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the county auditor of Franklin County, Ohio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected; and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the county treasurer of Franklin County, Ohio, in five (5) equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of five and one-half per cent (5½%) per annum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof when collected shall be applied to the payment of the bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of special assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same becomes due and to no other purpose.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
