To kery special assessments for the improvement of Peck Avenue from Main Street to the south line of Astor Avenue.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of

Chie:

Section 1. That, to pay the cost and expense heretofore determined to be levied and assessed for the improvement of Seck Avenue from Main Street to the South Line of Astor Avenue in Rider's Addition to said village, by grading, curbing and paving the roadway with asphalt, constructing the necessary streets severs to furnish proper drainage for said improvement, constructing a six inch water main with necessary fire hydrants in said avenue between the points aforesaid and making water connections therefrom to the letter and lands fronting and abutting thereon, smounting in the aggregate to \$23,755.16, as reported to this council by the engineer of said village, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon the lots and lands hereinafter described, and bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts as follows, to-wit:

and it is hereby determined and declared by this council that said lots are specially benefited by said improvement in an amount equal to the assessment levied thereon.

Section 2. That the assessments levied as aforesaid shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the County Auditor of Franklin County, Chio, as provided by law, to be by him placed upon the tax duplicate for collection as other taxes are collected; and that said assessments shall be payable at the office of the treasurer of Franklin County, Chio, in nine equal annual installments with interest thereon at the rate of five and one half per cent. (5%) per unnum payable semi-annually from and after the first day of October, 1922.

Section 3. That said assessments and all portions thereof, shall be applied to the payment of the bends issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of the special assessments for said improvement and the interest thereon as the same become due and to no other purpose.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
