

AN ORDINANCE NO. 370.

To amend Sections 3 and 4 of Ordinance No. 164, passed September 11, 1917, entitled "An Ordinance No. 164 determining to proceed with the improvement of Ashbourne Road in the Village of Bexley, Ohio,"

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Section 3 of Ordinance No. 164 passed September 11th, 1917, and entitled "An Ordinance No. 164 determining to proceed with the improvement of Ashbourne Road in the Village of Bexley, Ohio, be amended to read as follows:

Section 3. That the total cost of said improvement, together with the interest on bonds issued in anticipation of the levy and of the collection of special assessments for said improvement and all other necessary expenses shall be levied and assessed by the foot front, as petitioned for by the owners, upon the following described lots and lands to-wit: All of the lots and lands bounding, fronting and abutting upon said improvement which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement, and, in an amount equal to the cost thereof.

Section 2. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 164 hereinbefore referred to, be amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine (9) equal annual installments with interest on deferred payments at the rate of 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ % per annum payable semi-annually.
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Section 3. That Sections 3 and 4 of said ordinance No. 164 be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
