

AN ORDINANCE NO. 372.

To amend Section 4 of Ordinance No. 344 passed June 6, 1922, entitled "An Ordinance No. 344 determining to proceed with the improvement of Peck Avenue from Main Street to the south line of Astor Avenue.

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Berley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Section 4 of Ordinance No. 344 passed June 6, 1922, entitled "An Ordinance No. 344 determining to proceed with the improvement of Peck Avenue from Main Street to the south line of Astor Avenue," be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 4. That the assessments so to be levied shall be paid in nine (9) equal annual installments with interest upon the deferred payments at the same rate of interest as shall be borne by the bonds to be hereafter issued in anticipation of the levy and the collection of such assessments.

Section 2. That original Section 4 of said Ordinance No. 344, be and the same hereby is repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
