AN ORDINANCE NO. 374.

TO A STATE OF THE PROPERTY OF

To smend Sections one (1) and two (2) of an ordinance No. 201, "To fix the location and width, and establish the grade of sidewalks on Parkview Avenue from Main Street to the South Line of Broad Street."

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley, State

of chio:

Section 1. That Sections 1 and 2 of ordinance No. 201, "To fix the location and width, and establish the grade of sidewalks on Parkets Avenue from Main Street to the south lime of Broad Street be and the same hereby is smended to read as follows:

Section 1. That the sidewalks, when constructed on Parkview Arenue from the north line of Main Street to the south line of Broad Street shall be two (5) feet in width, with the inner edge thereof eight (8) feet from the let line; and, that the foot of the terrace slope shall not be more than three (3) feet from the property line, except on the east side of said avenue from the north lime of Main Street, Sta.) plus 40 to Sta. 1 plus 72, the walk shall be placed with the inside edge (or edge next to the property line) thirteen (13) feet from the back edge of the curb; from Sta. 1 plus 78 the walk shall rum with a reverse curve to sta..2 plus 00, at which point the inside edge shall be eighteen (13) feet from the back edge of the curb; from Sta. 2 plus 00 to Sta. 6 plus 63 (the south line of Town Street) the inside edge shall be eighteen feet from the back edge of the curb.

Section 2. The grade of said sidewalk shall be as follows, Beginning at the inside edge of the present walk on Main Street, Sta. 0 plus 34 and elevation 83.70; thence northerly to Sta. 0 plus45, elevation 84.40; thence gortherly with a vertical curve to Ste. 0 plus 75, elevation 85.60; thence northerly to Sta. 1 plus 00, elevation 85.90; thence northerly to Sta. 1 plus 36, elevation 85.80; thence northerly to Sta. 1plus 80, elevation 85.70; thence northerly to Sta. 1 plus 93, Mavation 84.95; thence northerly to Sta. 2 plus 25, elevation tion 87.10; thence necessary to Sta. 2 plus 75, elevation 87.50; thence northerly to Sta. 3 plus 06, election 88.70; thence northerly to Sta. 3 plus 55, elevation 90.00; thence northerly to Sta. 4 plus 00, elevation 91.10; thence northerly to Sta. 4 plus 15, elevation 91.30; thence to Sta. 4 plus 30, elevation 91.10; thence northerly to Sta. 4 plus 45. elevation 91.00; thence northerly to Sta. 5 plus 23, elevation 91.40; thence northerly to Sta. 5 plus 66, elevation 91.00; thence northerly to Sta, 5 plus 87, elevation 90.90; thence northerly to Sta. 6 plus 63, elevation 91.40; (the south line of Town Street); The grade of said sidewalks on the west side of Perkview Avenue from Main Street to the south line of Town Street shall be as follows: from the north line of Main Street, Sta. 2, the elevation of the inside edge of said sidewalk shall be 8" above the curb; from Sta. 2 to 4 this shall increase until at Sta. 4 it shall be 13" above the curb; from the

north line of Town Street to Sta. 16, plus 60 the elevations shall be 4" above the curb grade from which point to Sta. 19 plus 72 it shall gradually increase to an elevation of $25\frac{1}{3}$ " above the curb on the east side and 15" above the curb on the west side, from which point it shall decrease to Sta. 22 plus 50, at which point the elevation shall be 8" above the curb and continue said elevation to the south line of Broad Street.

Section 5. That ordinance No. 201 passed May 27th, 1919, entitled an ordinance "To fix the location and width and establish the grade of sidewalks on Parksiew Avenue from Main Street to Broad Street to and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
