

AN ORDINANCE NO. 377.

To designate the materials and to fix the grade, location and width of sidewalks on Peck Avenue between Main Street and Astor Avenue.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Selsey, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the sidewalks, when constructed, on Peck Avenue between Main Street and Astor Avenue in said village shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the general plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by the council of said village.

Section 2. That said sidewalks shall be not less than five feet (5) in width with a cross slope of three eighths ($\frac{3}{8}$) of an inch per foot, and the foot of the terrace slope shall not extend into the street beyond the lot line.


Section 3. That said sidewalks shall be located as follows: The walks shall be constructed with the inner edge (or edge next to the lot line) eleven and one half ($11\frac{1}{2}$) feet from the back edge of the curb.

Section 4. That the grade of the inside edge of the sidewalks, located as aforesaid, shall be as follows: the inside edge of said walks shall be five and one half ($5\frac{1}{2}$) inches above the curb and shall run parallel therewith.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
