AN ORDINANCE NO. 378.

By Mr. Manly.

To designate the material and to fix the grade, location and width of sidewalks on Cassady Avenue between Brentwood Road and Broad Street.

Be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Bexley, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the sidewalks when constructed on Cassedy Avenue between Brentwood Road and Broad Street, in said village, shall be constructed of concrete in accordance with the general plans and specifications for sidewalks heretofore adopted by the council of said village.

Section 2. That said sidewalks shall be not less than five (5) feet in width with a cross slope of three eighths (3/8) of an inch per foot, with the foot of the terrace slope not nearer than one foot to the inside edge of the walk (or the edge next to the lot line).

Section 3. That said sidewalks shall be located as follows: From the north line of Brentwood Road to the south line of Fair Avenue the walks shall be constructed with the inside edge (or edge next to the lot line) twenty three and one half $(23\frac{1}{2})$ feet from the back of the curb; from the north line of Fair Avenue teams south line of Broad Street the inside edge shall be thirteen and one-half $(13\frac{1}{2})$ feet from the back edge of the curb.

section 4. The grade of the inside edge of the walk, located as aforesaid, shall be as follows: from the north line of Brentwood Road to the south line of Fair Avenue the inside edge of the sidewalks shall be ten (10) inches above the curb, and shall run parallel therewith; from the north line of Fair Avenue to the south line of Broad Street the inside edge of the sidewalks shall be six (6) inches above the curb and shall run parallel therewith.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
