ORDINANCE NO. 380.

To change the name of France Avenue and Rudolph Avenue from the north line of Rudolph's Addition to the north line of Berhay Place.

WHEREAS, on the 18th. day of October, 1922, a petition, by persons owning lets in the immediate vicinity of France Avenue and Rudelph Avenue from the north line of Rudelph's Addition to the north line of Bexley Place, was duly presented to the council praying that the name of France Avenue be changed to Ardmore Road and that the name of Rudelph Avenue be changed to Cassingham Road; and,

Be it ordained by the council of the Village of Bexley,

Section 1. That the name of France Avenue from the north line of Bexley Place be and the same hereby is changed to archere Read and that the name of Rudolph Avenue between the same points be changed to Cassingham Road.

Section 2. That this ordinance shall take effect and he in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
